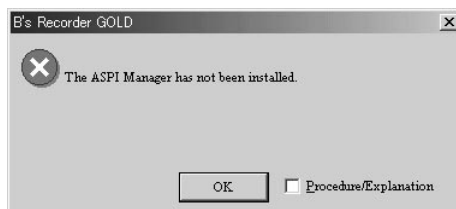


## Precautions when using the CD-R/RW Drive or the included software under Windows

### Updating B's Recorder GOLD and the ASPI Manager

Depending on your computer, the following error message may appear when you start B's Recorder GOLD (included with the CD-R/RW Drive).



In this case, you need to update the ASPI Manager. Click [OK] to close the error message, then end B's Recorder GOLD.

Methods for updating the ASPI Manager vary with different versions of Windows. For details, see **FAQs** at <http://www.bhacorp.com/support/index.html>.

### B's Clip does not support writing to CD-R discs

Note that B's Clip (included with this drive) does not support writing to CD-R discs, nor can such discs be formatted.

\* Use B's Recorder GOLD to write to CD-R discs.

### Playing a Music CD with B's Player

When B's Player (included on the provided CD-ROM) is used to play a music CD that has no CD Text information, it may work improperly. In this case, click [Environment...] button of B's Player to open the [Environment Properties] dialog box, then click [CD-ROM Drive Settings] tab, and then turn off the [Search CD TEXT when recognizing audio CD] check box. (B's Player is automatically installed when B's Recorder GOLD is installed.)

### Special software is needed to create an MP3 file

In order to create MP3 files, a "ripper" (separate encoding software) is required. (The software included on the provided CD-ROM can not be used to create MP3 files).



# **Precautions when using the CD-R/RW drive or the included software under a Macintosh**

## **When the drive is not recognized**

There are rare occasions when the drive is not recognized. In this case, remove the i.LINK connector from the computer, then turn off the power of the drive and reconnect the drive to the computer by following the steps indicated in “Quick Guide”.

## **Playing a Music CD or a VIDEO CD**

We recommend you to use a standard CD-ROM drive for Macintosh to play music from a music CD, CD-EXTRA, or game CD, or to play video with a VIDEO CD. (Depending on the CD being played, Macintosh may not operate stably when using this CD-R/RW drive.)

## **Warnings when using iTunes**

When iTunes is used together with the included software, make sure to turn off the “Firewire Authoring Support” extension. If this extension is not turned off, the software extension and iTunes will conflict, causing both of them to work improperly. Also, the included B’s Recorder GOLD and DiscDup software cannot be used simultaneously with iTunes. End iTunes to use B’s Recorder GOLD or DiscDup.

## **Special software is needed to create an MP3 file**

In order to create MP3 files, a “ripper” (separate encoding software) is required. (The software included on the provided CD-ROM can not be used to create MP3 files).

## **Precaution when creating a music CD**

B’s Recorder GOLD can be used to create a single music CD containing songs from different CDs. First, convert all the selected songs on different music CDs into AIFF format, then save them to the hard disk. Then, use B’s Recorder GOLD to write the AIFF files to a CD-R disc. If songs from a music CD are registered to the Well in CD-DA format, other songs cannot be registered from a different music CD.

## **The CRX1650L cannot be used to play CD-I disc**

The CRX1650L cannot be used to play a CD-I disc. In order to play a CD-I disc, use a standard CD-ROM or DVD-ROM drive in the Macintosh.
