

How to Connect to the Internet Using AOL with Netscape

The version of America On-Line, (AOL), that ships on a PCV70/90 is the 16-bit version. The version of Netscape Navigator is the 32-bit version. These two version will not work together. When signing on with AOL, you should upgrade AOL to the 32-bit version to use Netscape Navigator as the browser. This is not an issue with later models (PCV100/120 and newer) which ship with a 32-bit version of AOL.

To get the upgraded version of AOL do the following:

1. Connect to AOL.
2. Enter the keyword "GET95."
3. Download the AOL for Windows 95 upgrade.
4. Install the new version of AOL.
5. Use the same screen and password and reconnect to AOL.
6. Minimize AOL.
7. Start Netscape Navigator and it will automatically connect to AOL.
8. Once you confirm that the new version works you can then delete the older version of AOL. If Windows 95 asks you if you wish to delete files shared by other applications, answer "NO" to prevent files used by the newer version from being deleted.
