
How to Reinstall the Video Drivers? PCV 130 150 200

Follow the steps below to reinstall the video drivers on a PCV 130 150 200.

1. Insert the Application Recovery CD into the CDROM drive.
2. Click Start, point to Settings, and click Control Panel.
3. Double-click the Display icon.
4. Click the Settings tab.
5. Click the Advanced Properties button.
6. Click the Adapter tab.
7. Click the Change button.
8. At the Select Device window, click the Have Disk button.
9. In the Install From Disk window, under Copy Manufacturer Files From, type G:\Drivers\Video.
10. Click OK.
11. At the Selected Device window, click to highlight All-in-Wonder (Direct Draw) from the list.
12. Click OK.

NOTE: If the All-In-Wonder (Direct Draw) does not appear as an option, click Show All Devices and then select the All-In-Wonder (Direct Draw).

12. At the Advanced Display properties window, click Close.
13. Click OK to close Display Properties.
14. At the System Settings Change window, click Yes to restart the computer.

NOTE: The monitor type has may have been changed to "Unknown" by this. Follow the procedure below to confirm the proper monitor is selected for the system.

- (A) Click Start, point to Settings, click Control panel.
- (B) Double-click the Display icon.
- (C) Click the Settings tab.
- (D) Click the Advanced Properties button.
- (E) Click the Monitor tab.

(F) If the appropriate monitor is already selected, click Cancel. If not go to step (G).

(G) If the appropriate monitor is not selected, click the Change button.

(H) At the Change Display Type window, under Monitor Type, click the Change button.

(I) Click to select Show All Devices.

(J) Under manufacturer, scroll to select the monitor manufacturer.

(K) Under model, scroll to select the monitor model.

DRIVER NOTE: If using an INF file from a disk, follow this sub-procedure.

1. Insert the floppy disk and click the Have Disk button.
2. Under Copy Manufacturers files from, click the down arrow.
3. From the drop-down menu, select A:\ and click OK.
4. Click to highlight the correct monitor model. Continue to step (L).

NOTE: If the proper monitor is not listed, Standard VGA 640x480 may work. If that is not successful, please contact the manufacturer of the monitor for a Windows 95 INF disk for that specific monitor.

(L) Click OK.

(M) Click Close.

(N) At the Display Properties box, click OK.
