
How To Selectively Restore Files (SFR) Or Applications From The Recovery CDs? PCV 220 240

The System Recovery CD offers an option called a Single File Restore (SFR) which enables you to restore a specific file or directory by entering the DOS path and file name. The Application Recovery CD offers pre-defined application restores, such as Communication Center and AV Suite. This solution is broken into two sections.

RECOVERY CD NOTE: Always be sure to use the Recovery CD designed for your model computer (e.g. DO NOT use a PCV 90 Recovery CD on a PCG 707).

CERTIFICATE NOTE: BEFORE performing a Windows restore, or Registry restore, please verify that you have the Certificate of Authenticity available. There will be a prompt for this certificate number after the restore is complete and the computer is restarted.

Section I. RESTORE A SPECIFIC FILE OR DIRECTORY.

1. Insert the System Recovery CD #1 into the CDROM drive.
2. Restart the computer.
 - A. Click Start and click Shutdown.
 - B. Select Restart and click OK.
3. At the Welcome screen, click OK.
4. At the Main Menu screen, Press Alt+F10.
5. In the Single File Restore box, type the path of the file to be restored and click OK.

NOTE: DO NOT use a drive letter or initial backslash in the path. For example:

Windows\Win.ini (restores Win.ini in the Windows folder)

Windows\calc.exe (restores calc.exe in the Windows folder)

autoexec.bat (restores autoexec.bat in the root directory)

6. Once the path is restored, click Restart to restart the system.

Section II. RESTORE AN APPLICATION FROM THE APPLICATION RECOVERY CD.

A selective restore of specific applications and drivers can be restored using the Application Recovery CD.

1. Insert the Application CD into the CDROM drive. It should autorun.

If it does not autorun:

- A. Double-click the My Computer icon.
- B. Double-click the (G:) drive icon.
- C. Double-click the Install icon.

2. At the Welcome screen, click OK.

3. Navigate to the folder that contains the desired application and double-click its icon. The setup program will begin. Follow the prompts to complete the installation process.
