

When Using The Quicken Online Features, The GTE Trial Internet Account Prompts For A Password. PCV E314DS E518DS L400 L600 PCG 505TS/TX 838 C1X F150 F160 F180 F190

When accessing the Internet via Quicken, the online features prompt for a password, although the GTE Internet trial account does not normally require password input. This occurs because the GTE trial connection will not automatically populate the Quicken online features with the necessary user information. To use the Quicken online features with the GTE Internet account, connect to the Internet first using the GTE Easy Internet browser or the GTE dialer in Dial-Up Networking and then launch the Quicken online features. Follow the steps below to connect to GTE using the Easy Internet browser.

NOTE: This solution assumes that you have already established your GTE trial membership.

1. Confirm that the modem is properly connected to a live phone jack.
2. Click Start, point to Internet Access, and click GTE Internet Access.
3. Click the GTE button to connect to the Internet.
4. At the top right, click the - (minus) button to minimize the GTE window.
5. Launch Quicken and access the online features.
