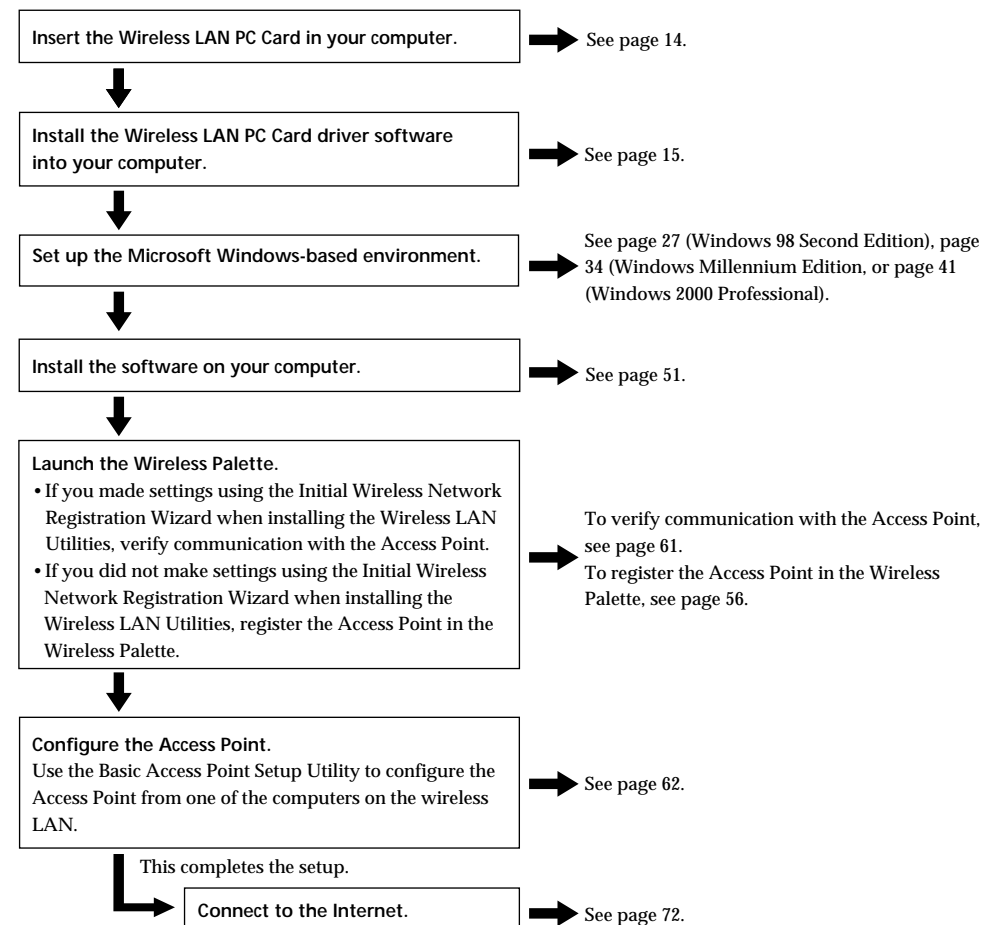

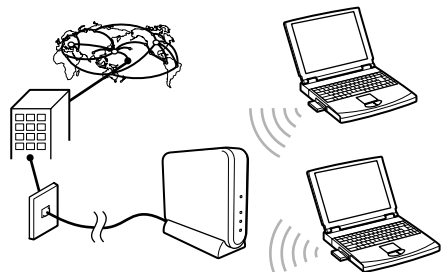

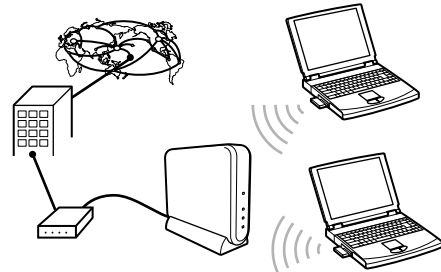

(PCWA-A100 only^{*1})



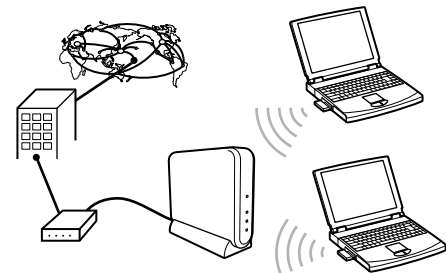

Internet access via cable modem



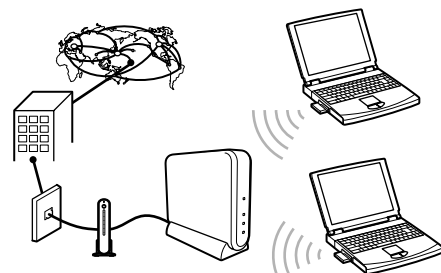

Internet access via DSL modem (PPPoE)



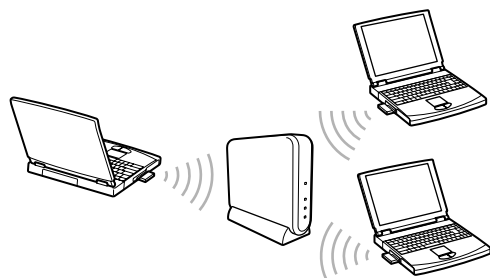

Internet access via ISDN router



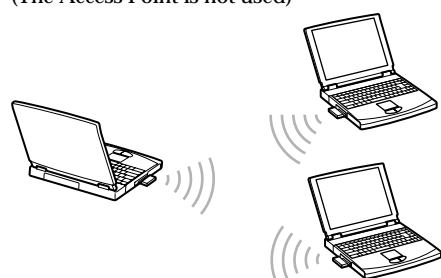
